MEET SUMMONS

The St Vincent and the Grenadines Swimming Federation (SVGSF) extends to you a cordial invitation to attend the annual Scotiabank Invitational swim meet to be held at the Shrewsbury Aquatic Centre at Ratho Mill, St Vincent and the Grenadines. This event is sanctioned by the SVGSF in accordance with FINA Rules.

1. POOL SPECIFICATIONS: 6 LANE 25 M POOL, Colorado Electronic Timing System. Warm-down (10m) pool available.

2. SCHEDULE:

The pool will be open for warm-up 90 minutes before each session and will be closed 15 minutes before the start of each session.

3. COMPETITION RULES:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with FINA Rules 2013-2017 in force at the start of the competition. FINA Rule SW 4.4 shall be applied. Throughout the Meet there will be a no FALSE-START rule for age groups 9-10 and older, and a two false start rule for younger age groups.

The starts, where possible, may be 'over the top' in the freestyle, breaststroke, butterfly and individual medley events.

4. AGE GROUPS:

Individual events: -

6 & Under;

7 - 8,

9 - 10,

11 - 12,

13 - 14.

15 & OVER

Relays:

Freestyle Relays will be in age groups 10 & Under; 11 to 14 and 15 & Over.

The Swimmer's age on December 31st, 2016 will determine the age group in which he/she is eligible to participate

Events may be swam as age group events and/or open events. However, irrespective of how swam, they will be scored by age group as above.

In the open events the minimum age is 9 years old.

5. REGISTRATION, ENTRIES & Rules:

Each Club must submit a letter of sanction to the Meet Director from its Federation indicating that participating swimmers and clubs are in good financial standing. Competitors must be registered swimmers with the Federation of the Country sanctioning their participation.

Entries MUST be made using the Hy-Tek Team Manager file and MUST reach the Organizing Committee no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>January 27th 2017 at 6pm</u>. Entries should be sent by email to <u>sygasa@gmail.com</u>

The following rules shall apply to all entries:

Events may be swam as age group events and/or open events. However, irrespective of how swam, they will be scored by age group as above.

- 1. There is no limit to the number of swimmers which a Club can enter in an individual event. However only the two highest placed swimmers in a particular Club will score team points.
- 2. Each Club may enter multiple teams per relay event but only the first relay team per club will score team points. Each Club will designate the scoring relay team as team A. Teams B, C & others will not be eligible for team points.
- 3. There shall be no restrictions on the number of events in which an individual competitor may participate.
- 4. Swimmers missing their respective heat will not be allowed to take part in that event
- 5. There will be no heats or preliminaries. All events are timed finals.
- 6. The pool will be open 90 minutes before each session for warm-up.
- 7. The warm up routine will be an open lane format with sprinting taking place in lanes 1 & 6 for 20 minutes before the end of the warm-up session. Pace laps will take place in the inner lanes.
- 8. Swimmers competing in relay events must be registered in the meet.
- 9. Ad hoc deck entries will NOT be accepted.
- 10. Swimmers must report to the waiting area at least 5 heats before the event in which he/she has been entered. If the swimmer is not in the waiting area by the designated time a decision may be taken that the swimmer has scratched the event.

11. Time Trials:

All requests for time trials must be submitted each day before the start of the day's session on the prescribed form indicating the following: Name of the Swimmer, Sex, Age, Club affiliation and the event. Swimmers requesting time trials must be entered in the meet and the fee is US \$5.00 (EC \$12) for each event requested.

6. Entry fees:

Entry fees are as follows:

- (a) US \$20 (EC\$55) per team (for teams of more than 5 swimmers) PLUS:
- (b) US\$2.00 (EC\$5) per event per swimmer.
- (c) All scratches after Wednesday, February 8th will be charged the penalty fee of US\$7.00 or EC \$20.00. The penalty must be paid before the swimmer is eligible to swim in other events in this meet or in subsequent SVGSF organized meets. Each Club is required to submit to the SVGSF Office the name of their scratch fee Coordinator, i.e. the person from whom the scratch fee will be collected on behalf of the Club.

Entry fees must accompany entries. Participating Clubs from overseas are required to pay entry fees on arrival.

7. AWARDS:

- a. Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) swimmers in each event for all age categories of 12 and below.
- b. The team scoring the highest overall points shall be the winning team and shall be awarded a trophy.
- c. Team points will be accumulated in each age group (top two swimmers for each team finishing in the top eight positions) and relay events.
- d. Team trophy will be presented following the last event and medals will be given to the team delegates.
- e. Trophies will be awarded in each age group category to the top male and top female swimmers with the highest aggregate of points. Relay points will not be taken into consideration in this category of award.

8. SCORING:

Individual Scoring shall be as follows:

First Place -9 points Second Place -7 points Third Place -6 points Fourth Place -5 points Fifth Place -4 points Sixth Place -3 points 2 points Seventh Place-Eighth Place -1 point

9. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS:

The SVGSF in conjunction with the affiliated Swim Clubs in St Vincent will provide the Officials for the competition. Overseas clubs are invited to submit the names of any qualified persons willing to serve as Timers / Judges for the meet.

All meet officials are required to check in with the Meet Referee and Chief Timer one hour before the start of the competition.

Refreshment will be served to Meet Officials during the Competition.

10. TECHNICAL MEETING:

A brief Technical meeting will be held at the Shrewsbury Aquatic Centre on Friday, February 10th, 2017 at 5pm.
