4. COMPETITION RULES

<u>A – POOL SWIMMING</u>

4.1. THE COMPETITION

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with World Aquatics (WA) Rules in force at the start of the competition. WA Rule SW 4.4 shall be applied. Throughout the Meet there will be a no FALSE-START rule for age groups 9-10 and older, and a two false start rule for age 8 & Under.

4.2. INTERPRETATIONS

The Organizing Committee and the Jury of Appeal shall have complete authority to answer and resolve any interpretation, resolution and call relating to this Competition. Nominations for the Jury of Appeal should be submitted at the Technical Meetings. Video footage may not be used to dispute decisions of the Meet Referee. World Aquatics rules do not allow for video replays to be used as evidence

4.3. AGE GROUPS

Competitors will compete in the following age groups:

- 8 & Under
- 9 10
- 11 12
- 13 14
- 15 17
- 18 & Over

All events will be swum according to Age Group <u>except</u> the 400m Free, which will be swum as an Open Event, but scored according to Age Group.

For the relay events, the age groups shall be as follows:

- 10 & Under
- 11-14
- 15 & Over

The swimmer's age group shall be determined by the age of the swimmer as of **midnight** on 31st December 2023.





<u>5. ELIGIBIITY</u>

- **A.** All Federations must be in good standing with World Aquatics, proof of which shall be demonstrated in the form of a copy of the receipt for the World Aquatics and Pan Am Aquatics annual subscription fees. Such receipt is to be submitted at the technical meeting.
- **B.** <u>All competitors must be citizens and/or residents of the country they represent. In the case of</u> residents, they must have been resident for a minimum of 12 months preceding the start date of the OECS Championships.

<u>6. ENTRIES</u>

- A. There will be a limit of 4 Competitors in each sex per age group to a Maximum of 34 swimmers
- B. There is no limit to the number of events per swimmer.
- C. No substitutions or alternates will be accepted after the final entries have been submitted, except in relays. All relay participants must have been entered in the meet.
- D. No Competitor will be able to participate in an age group outside of his or her age group even if it is in an age group older than the competitor.
- E. Each Country will be limited to two (2) competitors per individual event and one (1) team per relay event **for points**; however it will be permitted to include more competitors to the maximum of four (4) in each event.
- F. In the relays each Country must enter 4 competitors. <u>Entries for relay events MUST include</u> the names of the swimmers when the HyTek entry is submitted in accordance with the entry <u>deadline of October 11th, 2024</u>. The order of the swimmers in each relay of the day's proceedings may be changed by submitting this information to the Clerk of Course two hours before the start of each session.
- G. <u>ALL Competitors must be entered with a SEED TIME</u>. Entries with No Time (NT) will be rejected.
- H. Swimmers will be seeded in each event according to ENTRY TIMES.
- I. All events will be swum as timed finals.
- J. A Resolution desk will be set up outside of the Computer Room, any issues, protests, concerns must be handled at this desk, as no one will be allowed inside the Computer Room except for one pool attendant and persons accredited to work in that space.
- K. Entries must be made using Hy-Tek Team Manager entry file and must reach the Organizing Committee no later than Friday, 11th October 2024 at midnight. In addition, entries should also be sent in PDF format. <u>All entries should be sent by email using available</u> <u>Hy-tek file, to:</u>

<u>The Psych sheet will be issued no later than Friday, October 18th. Teams are responsible for checking the accuracy of their entries. All scratches or corrections <u>MUST be received within 7 days of the issuing of the Psych sheet. Any scratches or no shows after the 7 days deadline will incur a fee of \$50 per swimmer per event.</u></u>

<u>7. TEAM OFFICIALS</u>

Each participating Country may include in its delegation the following officials for accreditation:

- A. Delegations of twelve (12) competitors or less will be allowed three (3) team officials,
- B. Delegations of thirteen (13) to twenty-four (24) competitors will be allowed four (4) team officials,
- C. Delegations of twenty-five (25) to thirty-four (34) competitors will be allowed five (5) team officials,
- D. The name and role of each official must be indicated along with the entries.

8. REGISTRATION/ACCREDITATION PROCEDURE

Prior to the start of the competition, the Head of Delegation will:

- 1. Pay to the Organizing Committee the sum total of meet fees as invoiced by the host Country based on the final entries. Invoices will be sent to the National Federations prior to arrival.
- 2. Accreditation badges will be issued for each member of the official delegation after payment has been made.
- 3. The accreditation card must be carried at all times. The loss of an accreditation card must be reported to the Meet Director and may be replaced at a cost of EC \$40.00.





<mark>9. FEES</mark>

A. Meet Fees for the Competition are as follows:

<u>Team Fees: EC \$100 (US\$40) per OECS team entry.</u> Individual Fees: EC \$25 (US\$10) per OECS swimmer.

Meet fees must be paid before the start of the Meet to the SVGSF Treasurer. No swimmer will be permitted to participate in the meet in any event unless they are registered in the Meet and the entry fee has been paid.

B. Spectator/Supporter Fees will be as follows:

- EC\$10 per session (Adult)
- EC\$25 Weekend Pass (Adult)
- EC\$5 per session (Child aged 10 and Under)
- Children under 5 years no charge

10. TECHNICAL MEETING

There will be a brief Technical Meeting on <u>*Friday 8th November 2024 at 8.30am*</u> at the Shrewsbury Aquatic Centre. At this meeting, swimmers may <u>NOT</u> be scratched from events and no alternates or substitutes or additional entries will be permitted. <u>Teams MUST send scratches</u> <u>before October 25th</u>. Any scratches or no shows after October 25th will incur a fee of \$50 per swimmer per event.

- A. A High Point Championship Trophy will be awarded to the top team.
- B. Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place OECS swimmer in each event.
- C. A High Point Individual Trophy will be presented to the OECS champion in each age group (female & male).
- D. Medals will be presented ONLY to those in the age 12 & Under age categories. <u>Medals for</u> those age 13 and above will be provided to each Countries respective Team Managers for presentation to the winners. ALL record breaking performances will be recognized.

12. OPENING OF POOL

The pool will be opened 90 minutes before the scheduled start of the Competition Session. The pool will be closed 10 minutes before the start of the competition. A warm-up schedule will be issued for all teams.

13. FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Each Delegation shall provide two (2) flags of their country no larger than 4 feet by 6 feet and a minimum of 3 x 5 feet.

14. CEREMONIES

- A. There will be an Opening Ceremony on the first day of the competition, Friday, 8th November, commencing at approximately 6:30 p.m.
- B. Medal award ceremonies will be held throughout the meet as time permits. Medals will be presented to winners in the age group 12 and Under. Medals for age 13 and above will be given to the team managers for their athletes.
- C. There will be a Closing Ceremony at the end of each championship when awards will be presented.





<mark>15. LIAISONS</mark>

The SVGSF has setup a team of liaison persons to assist each island in making their arrangements in St Vincent. The liaisons are listed in the table below.
